MEMBERS TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Parents/Carers should undertake to support the ethos of the Youth Club by engaging their children at home.
2. All members of the Youth Club partnership – parents/Carers, volunteers and youth club members – undertake to ensure that all members abide by the rules and regulations of the Youth Club.
3. All members must be between the ages of 9 and above.
4. Sessions will only be cancelled under exceptional circumstances and will normally run once a month, Sundays between 2pm - 4pm in the summer and 1pm – 3pm when the clocks go back.
5. A subscription of £1 must be paid at the beginning of every session
6. The Youth Club reserves the right to exclude any member disrupting the session or breaching the Youth Club rules and regulations, inside the masjid or outside immediately before or after the session.
7. Youth Club rules and regulations:

RULES

- **No bullying**
- **No foul language**
- **No drinking/eating inside**
- **No running**
- **listen and respect volunteers and other members of youth club**
- **look after equipment**
- **everyone has fair turns on equipment**

CONSEQUENCES

- **Fighting/bullying = get sent home**
 - **Break any other rule = 5 mins time out**
 - **Permanent exclusion if constantly breaking rules**
 - **Damage to equipment = exclusion/fine**
8. Must have regular attendance, be on time, good behavior and conduct towards all, refraining from vandalism, not possessing or consuming food items in the prayer halls or other places as decided upon by the volunteers. This list is not an exhaustive list, but members must conduct themselves as good citizens.
 9. Abuse both verbal and physical to volunteers/ members of the youth club and parents/members of the public will be dealt with as a breach of the Youth Club code resulting in expulsion.
 10. The Youth Clubs' decision is deemed as final but parents/Carers do have a right to appeal which will be heard by a panel made up of one member of the Youth Department and at least two members of the general Masjid committee.
 11. Parents/Carers are responsible for accompanying their child to and from the entrance door and collecting them on time. The Youth Club takes no responsibility for children whose parents arrive early or late.
 12. Toys, mobile phones and other electronic devices should not be brought to the Youth Club as the Youth Club will not be held responsible or liable for any damage caused.
 13. Sweets/chewing gum are strictly prohibited.
 14. The Youth Club reserves the right to change any of the terms, fees, timings, but will give notice of these to parents.
 15. Parents/Carers must use the Masjid car park when dropping off or collecting their children. Blocking entrances and roads is a serious fire and safety hazard. Remember you could be endangering someone's life.
