## Members' terms and conditions

1. Parents/Carers should undertake to support the ethos of the Youth Club by engaging their children at home.
2. Parents/Carers agree to work in partnership with the Youth Club volunteers.
3. All members of the Youth Club partnership – parents/Carers, volunteers and youth club members – undertake to ensure that all members abide by the rules and regulations of the Youth Club.
4. Parents/Carers agree to attend all parent/Carer – Youth Club volunteer meetings.
5. All members must be between the ages of 8-16.
6. Sessions will only be cancelled under exceptional circumstances and will normally run every fortnight, Fridays between 7:00pm - 8:30pm or with the times agreed to be notified.
7. All members must bring their subs money to every session.
8. The Youth Club reserves the right to exclude any member disrupting the session or breaching the Youth Club rules and regulations, inside the premises or outside within a radius of 200m immediately before or after the session.
9. Youth Club rules include good time keeping, regular attendance of 90% or above, good behavior and conduct towards all, refraining from stealing and vandalism, not possessing or consuming food items in the prayer halls or other places as decided upon by the volunteers. This list is not an exhaustive list but members must conduct themselves as good citizens.
10. The Youth Club policy for discipline is a verbal warning, written warning and final written warning. After this the Youth Club will exclude the member indefinitely. Each of these stages will stay on record for a 6 month period. If the member is disciplined again within a 6 month period they will move up a disciplinary stage. Certain acts of a serious nature will result in immediate expulsion (see point 11). Discipline will also carry a minimum £10 fine.
11. Abuse both verbal and physical to volunteers/ members of the youth club and parents/members of the public will be dealt with as a breach of the Youth Club code resulting in expulsion.
12. The Youth Clubs' decision is deemed as final but parents/Carers do have a right to appeal which will be heard by a panel made up of one member of the Youth Department and at least two members of the general Masjid committee.
13. Parents/Carers are responsible for accompanying their child to and from the entrance door and collecting them on time. The Youth Club takes no responsibility for children whose parents arrive early or late.
14. Toys, mobile phones and other electronic devices should not be brought to the Youth Club as the Youth Club will not be held responsible or liable for any damage caused.
15. Any equipment which is damaged intentionally or due to not following instructions will have to be paid for in full.
16. Sweets/chewing gum are strictly prohibited and will result in a £10 fine for either possession or consumption.
17. The Youth Club reserves the right to change any of the terms, fees, timings, but will give notice of these to parents.
18. Parents/Carers must use the Masjid car park when dropping off or collecting their children. Blocking entrances and roads is a serious fire and safety hazard. Remember you could be endangering someone's life.
19. Every effort is made to maintain your child's safety, and well-being whilst visiting the Youth Club. In the unlikely event of an accident, or loss or damage to personal effects, Neeli Masjid will not assume any liability for any direct or indirect loss, damage or injury arising from use of the premises and car park.
20. I also agree to my child having their picture taken and published whilst participating in authorised Youth Club activities as deemed appropriate by the iCircle and Youth Club Youth Leader.
21. I also give authorisation for my child to be involved in the iCircle which will be education based (Islamic Studies and certain social contemporary topics).
